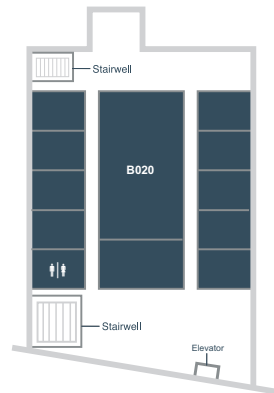




upper level

HERSHAEL YORK

All Scripture is God-breathed and profitable. So why do preachers skip over some parts? 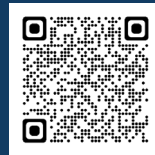

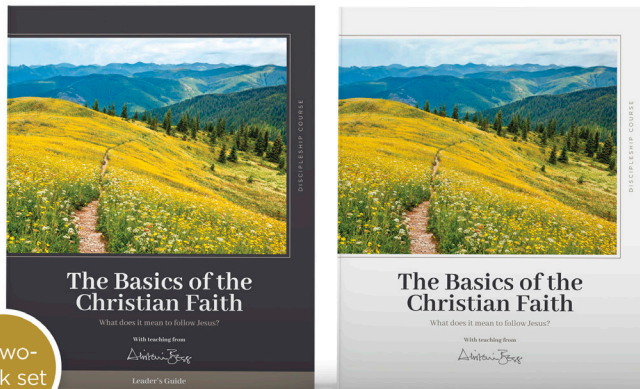

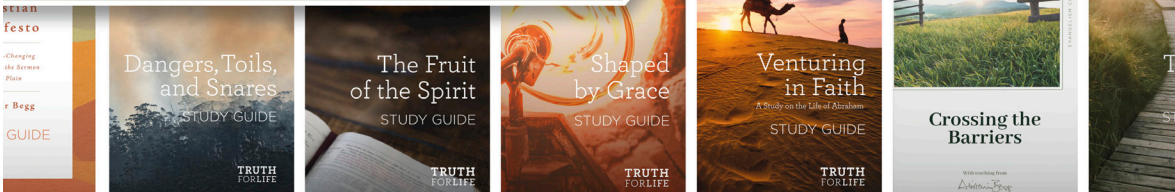
